

## Job Description – Security Design Consultant

**Department:** Consulting  
**Line Manager:** Head of Consultancy

### Role Overview:

Reporting directly to the Head of Consultancy within the security practice, this role is principally concerned with supporting the strategic advisory services to clients, to help them evaluate and manage their security related risks, and then transforming protection objectives (derived from the assessment of their risks) into mitigation measures through phased engineering design.

### Key Tasks and Responsibilities:

- The role requires a design consultant with expertise in a risk-based approach to design in the built environment and energy sectors. A person who has been consulting in a FEED environment for between 3 – 7 years.
- Experience of managing small to medium technical design projects.
- The role requires experience in the built environment and energy sectors, for architects, engineers, major oil companies and EPC's
- The individual should be able to plan consulting assignments – schedules, costings, resource plans and bills of materials
- The individual must have an understanding of project finance, contracts and commercials
- The role will involve capturing clients' operational requirements and critical success factors, managing stakeholder engagement as a prelude to producing a technical security design

### Essential Capabilities/Skills:

The candidate must have the following skills:

- Technical security designs
- Secure by design / CPTED Master-planning
- Business analysis and requirements engineering
- Threat and vulnerability assessments
- Geopolitical risk and CT design

### Experience/Qualifications

The candidate should have experience in:

- Secure by design process & CPTED Analysis
- Working as part of multi-disciplinary design teams within the built environment and energy sector
- Providing threat-based design guidance for security systems to clients covering:
  - Physical protection systems (gates, barriers etc.)
  - Electronic systems (CCTV, Access Control etc.)
  - Command and control
  - Systems integration
  - Security operational procedures and emergency planning

- Information Assurance
- Producing specifications for security systems design
- The candidate must have successfully delivered work packages in the built environment and energy sectors within Europe, Asia or the GCC region

The following qualifications are desirable:

- Degree level qualified from an established university
- Member of a professional body that is relevant to the technical security environment (such as but not limited to):
  - IEE
  - CLAS
  - CISSP
  - APM
  - ICE
  - ASIS
  - CIMC
  - CEng
- A master's degree in a relevant security or consulting discipline is desirable
- Project management qualifications (Prince 2 / APM /PMP etc.)
- SIRA Approved Security Consultant

### **Personal Attributes**

The candidate should be confident and work well within multi-disciplinary teams and must be willing to work in any country that the company conducts its business, such as Iraq, Afghanistan, Asia and the MENA region.

In addition, the candidate should be able to prove the ability to:

- Plan unstructured problems and assignments from scratch
- Present plans and proposals to clients
- Lead and run workshops with clients
- Learn quickly and to work well under pressure
- Listen attentively and express complex issues concisely to clients
- Show leadership and motivate colleagues
